Code of Practice:

I will follow the leader's instructions and show a positive attitude.

I will behave appropriately - with respect, politeness, and friendliness towards leaders, peers and other church members.

I will respect the building and strive to keep myself and others safe in the historic building.

I will respect the property as my own and will care for it and keep it clean.

I will be as punctual as possible.

I will use my mobile phone only in emergency situations during services and while in groups.

I will not take pictures of any children other than my own that include their faces and I will not post any pictures on social media which include anyone other than my own family.
